

# Clydebank Methodist Church

**35 Second Avenue  
Clydebank G81 3AB**

## How to get there

### **By Rail to Singer Station:**

This method comes highly recommended as the station is only a very short walk from the church. Trains leave both Central and Queen Street Stations (**Lower** Level) destined for Dalmuir, Balloch or Helensburgh. On Friday mornings trains leave Queen St at 09.53 and 10.23. Trains from Central are at 10.06 and 10.18 (**on these trains change at Partick**). The journey time is 22 minutes. On exiting Singer station travellers should turn left past the Job Centre building towards the traffic lights. Turn left at the lights into Second Avenue. The church is at the crest of the hill.

### **By Road:**

There is a Car Park at the church which will be available for Synod members. Drivers with a Blue Badge should let Janet Haggis know of their needs on the booking form.

The best approach for those travelling from the east or north to Glasgow is to use the M8 (or join from the M80). Use junction 19 to take the A814 exit to Clydebank/S.E.C.C. Proceed along the Clydeside Expressway until it ends close to the Clyde Tunnel. Drivers can then either follow the A814 to Clydebank and turn right into Kilbowie Road or turn left onto the A739 continuing to Anniesland Cross and then left onto the A82. There will then be a left turn into the northern end of Kilbowie Road. In either case the map adjacent should then be followed.

Synod members coming from the West or South West should make their way to either the Erskine Bridge or the Clyde Tunnel. Tunnel traffic can follow the directions above by continuing to Anniesland Cross and then left onto the A82. From the Erskine Bridge turn right onto the A82. The next roundabout with traffic lights is at the north end of Kilbowie Road and the map below should be followed.
