IICSA

The Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse (IICSA) will start its investigation into Child Protection in Religious Organisations and Settings on Monday March 16. JPIT Conference

This year's JPIT Conference, held on Saturday 7 March, called upon churches to challenge political and economic leaders ahead of COP26. In a pivotal year for climate justice, the conference urged churches to challenge economic and political assumptions and to become agents for change in addressing the climate emergency. Video: British Sign Language Peace


Learning the British Sign Language version of the Peace isn't just useful during the current situation, it is a great way to become a more inclusive church.
