
# **Advent and Christmas**

#### Methodist success in Eco Church Awards

More Methodist churches are signing up to be part of the Eco Church award scheme operated by A Rocha UK. Participation in the Eco Church awards for the 12 months until June 2022 shows an increase of 70 percent for Methodist Churches over the previous year.

There are now more than 640 Methodist and LEP churches registered for Eco Church, with four churches having achieved Gold. Read more here.

Each year, the Methodist Youth President undertakes an overseas visit in partnership with the Global Relationships team. In October 2022, James Carver undertook his visit to South Korea. "Something that amazed me was the deep respect for Methodist history the Korean Methodist Church has. Almost all of the Kwanglim churches had exhibitions and the main church, which has a strong relationship with Wesley's Chapel in London, had artefacts such as a copy of the death mask of John Wesley." #### Celebrate the 250th Anniversary of Amazing Grace Sunday 1 January 2023

The Revd John Newton was a former slave trade captain who came to faith when God saved him from a shipwreck and who later, anonymously, supported William Wilberforce in his successful campaign to have Parliament declare the slave trade illegal. Newton, deeply moved by his own redemption, wrote the hymn Amazing Grace to accompany his New Year's day sermon in 1773 in Olney, Buckinghamshire.
