Holocaust Memorial Day




Holocaust Memorial Day, **27 January**, is set aside to come together to remember, to learn about the Holocaust.

"Pastor Nubia used to sustain the feeding programme with produce that she grew in the church's allotment. However, recent excessive rain followed by extreme periods of heat had damaged her crops, made it difficult to germinate seeds and produced much smaller crops than before."
