# The 2023 Spring Budget



"There are big changes to benefits underway, some very welcome and some extremely worrying."

### **Church of Sanctuary**

Methodist churches in Brighton and Hove have been awarded Church of Sanctuary status. All five Methodist churches from the Brighton & Hove Methodist Circuit received the Church of Sanctuary award: Dorset Gardens; Patcham; Stanford Avenue; Woodingdean, and Hove. They are the first Methodist Churches in Britain to do so.

The City of Sanctuary movement began in 2007, when Sheffield became the UK's first ever City of Sanctuary. Since then, hundreds of local councils, schools, universities, libraries, theatres and more have been awarded with Sanctuary status, pledging to create a culture of solidarity, inclusivity and welcome.
