

### **District Policy Committee: Autumn 2024 update**

Since the spring Synod, the DPC has met three times on line and once, with the addition of other superintendents and the EDI officer, in person in Perth. That meeting, along with much of the business this year, related to the transition into a single circuit.

The committee also oversees matters of finance and property, the NPNP Recovery work in Strathclyde and scrutinises proposals for lay appointments as well as considering the vacancies for volunteer roles in the district.

At the spring Synod the DPC invited applications for a small sum of money (£3,000) which had been given by the Connexion from the MAPJ fund (Methodist Action on Poverty and Justice). As no applications from the district were forthcoming, the DPC allocated the money to the work of the Women's Hub in Dundee.
